**THE PRO-RECTORS FOR
EDUCATION AND INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS**

On 30 September 2007, after over 40 years of distinguished service in the College and including many spent in senior academic leadership posts, Professor Rees Rawlings, the Pro-Rector for Educational Quality, will be retiring.

With effect from 1 October 2007, Professor Julia Buckingham will be appointed to the role of Pro-Rector for Education and will relinquish her current post as Head of the Division of Neuroscience and Mental Health. Professor Buckingham will be responsible for education strategy and quality assurance, student welfare, the Centre for Educational Development, the Department of Humanities, and Music and Arts, and will take the lead on the Graduate Schools.

Professor Mary Ritter, the Pro-Rector for International Affairs, will continue and expand her international academic responsibilities, including the international dimension of the College's graduate activities, as well as having overall responsibility for the International Office, the Library, and the Roberts skills development programme for postgraduates and postdoctoral research staff.

Both Pro-Rectors will report to the Rector.
