

Topic: Revised Construction Health Safety and Environment Code of Practice (CoP)
Date - 10th May 2016

Summary

The [updated Construction Health, Safety and Environment Code of Practice 2016](#) (CHSE CoP 2016) has now been issued. The CHSE CoP 2016 is reviewed on an annual basis to ensure that construction works comply with changes to the Imperial College London 2015 Health and Safety Policy; the Health and Safety Regulations and other legislation relating to construction.

Introduction

The CHSE CoP 2016 sets out the management arrangements the Estates Development & Projects Division has in place to enable the division to implement College policy and procedures and to comply with Health and Safety regulations relating to construction projects.

The CHSE CoP is reviewed on an annual basis. All revisions are listed and dated on Page 2 of the CoP. The information contained within each of those updated sections comes in to immediate effect.

The division seeks to ensure that work activities do not adversely affect the health and safety of staff, students, visitors, general public and contractors that may be affected by construction works.

What is the procedure?

All organisations, teams and individuals involved in construction works at Imperial College London are to read and understand the implications of the CHSE CoP 2016, and subsequent revisions, to their area of work.
