What is it?

A fishing town on the south coast. Site of the famous Battle of Hastings in 1066.

Highlights:

- The <u>Old Town</u> with its independent shops, cafes and narrow passageways which are known locally as 'twittens'.
- The seafood restaurants serving freshly caught fish.
- The 1066 Battlefield and Abbey at Battle (15 minutes by train from Hastings).
- The pebble beach.

How do I get there?

Train: From St Pancras. The journey time is approx 2 hours.

Coach: 2 hours 45 minutes from London Victoria.
