#### What is it?

A trip to the one of the UK's most famous ancient, mysterious creations followed by a visit to the "City in the Countryside".

### Opening times and prices for Stonehenge:

Opening times differ throughout the year. Check the <u>Stonehenge website</u> for full details. Cost: £14.90 for students with a valid student ID card. You must book your ticket in advance.

#### How do I get there?

**Train:** From London Waterloo to Salisbury Station. The journey time is approx. 1 hour 30 minutes.

There is a <u>coach shuttle service</u> to and Stonehenge run by The Stonehenge Tour available from the station (tours times and fares available on the Stonehenge Tour website).

**Car:** Stonehenge - 2 miles W of Amesbury on junction of A303 and A344/A3607. Download Satnav information from the <u>Stonehenge website</u>.
