HEAD OF THE DIVISION OF INVESTIGATIVE SCIENCE

The College is pleased to announce the appointment of a new Head of the Division of Investigative Science.

Professor Martin Wilkins will take up this role on 1st August 2007.

Professor Wilkins is currently Professor of Clinical Pharmacology and Head of the Section of Experimental Medicine and Toxicology in the Division of Medicine. He is Director of the Imperial College Clinical Research Office and of the Sir John McMichael Centre for Clinical Investigation and Research at Hammersmith Hospital. He is also Deputy Director of the Department of Health Toxicology Unit, based at Hammersmith Hospital.

Professor Wilkins has spent most of his career in the field of Clinical Pharmacology and Clinical Trials. He runs an internationally competitive research programme in pulmonary hypertension from basic science to clinical trials. He recently led a successful £14M bid to the Wellcome Trust to develop the clinical research infrastructure on the Hammersmith Campus.

Professor Wilkins will succeed Professor Steve Bloom who has served with great distinction as Head of Division since its inception in September 1997.
