Dr Emma McCoy, Deputy Head of the Department of Mathematics, has accepted appointment as interim Head of the Department, following the resignation of Professor Ari Laptev, with effect from 6 July 2010.

Dr McCoy first joined the Department in 1991 as a PhD student and then as a Research Associate. She subsequently spent time at the Courant Institute, NYU before returning to Imperial in 1996, where she is currently a Senior Lecturer. Within the Department, she has held a variety of administrative roles including that of Admissions Tutor and Associate Head of Department. She has been heavily involved in promoting Mathematics in the wider community and has delivered many public lectures, including those organised by the London Mathematical Society and the Institute for Mathematics and its Applications. She is a regular contributor to the Royal Institution Mathematics Masterclass series. Her research interests are in Time Series Analysis and Wavelets, with application areas ranging from geophysics to finance.
